"I heard the Voice of the LORD, saying, 'Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?' Then said I, 'Here am I; send me," Isaiah 6:8.

Dear Beloved Saint of the Most High LORD,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. What a wonderful Name it is. We walk, talk, and live under, by, and for that Name. But, have you ever tried to convince someone of the Saving Grace and Power in that Name? Christians believe in that Name and even worship and praise that Name but few really live in the fullness provided to us in that Name. We are instructed by Jesus [through Paul] to preach His Word; "Preach the Word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine," 2 Timothy 4:2. This is more than just a suggestion, recommendation, or challenge. We are "CHARGED" to do so as is written in the previous verse; "I charge you therefore before God [our Father], and the Lord Jesus Christ ...," to preach, reprove, rebuke, and exhort.

It has been noticed that most Christians are "silent soldiers," not hiding in caves, but hiding in plain sight. It is far too often that a vocal person (Christian or unbeliever) is more likely to "reprove or rebuke" (condemn) another person just because they don't see eye to eye on a subject whether it is religion, politics, family matters, and even sports; and less likely to preach or exhort (lift up) a person to the Truth of His Word. Regardless of our actions to preach, reprove, rebuke, or exhort in the flesh or in the Spirit, we must always walk in LOVE and gentleness of spirit. If we act upon any of these four 'charges,' we need to be fully trained and prepared to answer His Call. Meaning, if we are to be "Instant in season, and out of season" for the LORD, we need to know His Word and walk in God's Wisdom and Understanding through the witnessing anointing of His Holy Spirit.

Point! Have you ever been talking to a person about our LORD and they replied, "Prove to me that there is a god?" Or, "Where's the proof that the man called Jesus is God or that He even existed?"

Why do I bring this up? A few weeks ago, we received a call from a young lady that lives here in the Midwest. Her call went from the front desk and worked its way down the hall to my desk because no one could satisfactorily answer her question. We believe that the caller was sincere in her quest for the answer. But our answers did not satisfy her. The caller explained that she had been raised

as a Jew and wanted information concerning Jesus. She was asking, "Where is Jesus in the Old Testament?" After several conversations with her, the real question became clear as she stated her fact, "There is only ONE GOD in the Old Testament and we are told to only worship the one true God, and therefore Jesus cannot be God, and since there is only one God, there cannot be a Trinity!" How would you reply to that statement? This is an ongoing dialogue between us.

If we are to take a cruise on this "Prove to me" ship, we must first ask or make the statement, "Prove to me that there is a god." Concerning this young lady who is standing firm on the Jewish teaching of only One God, I would say, "Prove to me that Moses, who wrote the Torah and said that there is only one God, ever existed." Proof – NO, there is no proof outside of the writings of the Old Testament, hand-me-down traditions, or man's teaching that Moses ever lived or existed! In fact, there is very little physical proof that any of the Old Testament writers ever existed. There are Roman writings and records that indicate a few of the kings that are mentioned in both the Old and New Testaments may have existed, but that alone doesn't prove any of the teachings of the Testaments.

To believe in any religion (even non-religions) a person has to have faith. You have to have faith to get up in the morning. Even if you see something, you have to have faith that it is real or that it is fake. Hearing something raises even more doubt. If you believe what you hear someone say, or even what you see (or think that you hear or see), then you have faith that it is true, even if it is a lie or not true. Many times we read between the lines of what is said and believe our own thoughts as being the truth. So where does believing and non-believing come into play concerning the LORD – Jesus – and the Holy Spirit? Everyone believes in something. Some say they don't just because they don't want to be accountable, but they are anyway.

I read again this morning in Revelation 21:8, "The fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death." This is a pretty broad scope of people who will not be in Heaven –

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but will burn in Hell. Let me ask you a question, how broad is "unbelieving?" Does that just mean disbelief in Jesus, or does it include believing that healing has passed away, or that the miracles worked by the Holy Spirit were only for the first generation of believers? Does verse 8 include all of the "white" lies that we keep telling our family, boss, friends, spouse, or pastor? These are deep questions and I won't pretend to provide the answers but pose the questions to stir your thinking concerning the purity of heart that we are expected to have as we walk before God. Is God Gracious – Merciful- and Forgiving? Praise His Name – YES! And I thank and praise His Name for His Mercy and Grace, especially toward me.

God is not a god of fear – confusion – or doubt. Those come from the enemy! Years ago, Christine and I were working with a young couple that visited our church. They were very poor but good people. She was a believer but he was not and doubted God. During one of our last meetings with them, he said to me, "Prove to me that there is a god apart from the Bible!" One could say, "Just look around, at nature, at creation, at life itself." But that is not proof to the evolutionists. Most of them will admit that something somewhere - somehow had to start the whole evolution process, but they don't know what, when, or who. I am reminded of the Words of Christ when confronted with the same ideology, "Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered, saying, Master, we would see a sign from thee? But He answered and said unto them, 'An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas: For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the Earth," Matthew 12:38-40.

Is there a verse in the Old Testament stating, 'The Son of God shall be born on December 25!' NO! One has to look at the Old Testament prophecies that were fulfilled by Jesus as recorded in the New Testament. There are reported to be over 350 fulfilled prophecies. The odds of one man fulfilling all of the prophecies are almost incalculable. Here are just a few:

- Messiah will bruise satan's head: "I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise His heel," Genesis 3:15; (Fulfilled) "... God sent forth His Son, made of a woman, made under the law, To redeem them that were under the law ...," Galatians 4:4-5.
- Judah's scepter (rule) shall not depart Him: "Judah, thou art he whom thy brethren shall praise ... is a lion's whelp ... The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto Him shall the gathering of the people be," Genesis 49:8-10; (Fulfilled) "Jesus ... the Son of Joseph ... was the

son of Juda," Luke 3:23-33.

- Jacob's offspring would bless the nations: "Jacob went out from Beer-sheba ..., he dreamed, and behold a ladder ... the LORD stood above it, and said ... 'thy seed shall be as the dust of the Earth ... in thy seed shall all the families of the Earth be blessed," Genesis 28:10-14; (Fulfilled) "The Holy Spirit descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from Heaven, which said, 'Thou art My beloved Son; in Thee I am well pleased' ... the Son of Joseph ... which was the son of Jacob ...," Luke 3:22-38.
- Eternal Kingdom from King David's offspring:

 "When thy days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with
 thy fathers, I will set up thy seed after thee, which shall
 proceed out of thy bowels, and I will establish His Kingdom. He shall build an house for My Name, and I will
 establish the Throne of His Kingdom forever," 2 Samuel
 7:12-13; (Fulfilled) "The book of the generation of Jesus
 Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham," Matthew
 1:1.
- God promised a lamb: "Abraham said, 'My son, God will provide Himself a Lamb for a burnt offering:' so they went both of them together," Genesis 22:8; (Fulfilled) "... John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God ...," John 1:29.
- A lamb without blemish: "... Israel ... shall take ... a lamb ... without blemish, a male of the first year ...," Exodus 12:3-5; (Fulfilled) "(You were redeemed with) the precious blood of Christ, as of a Lamb without blemish and without spot," 1 Peter 1:19.
- Christ is the Passover Lamb: "Moses called for all the elders of Israel, and said unto them, '... take you a lamb ... kill the Passover ... and dip (hyssop) in the blood ... strike the lintel and the two side posts ... For the LORD ... will see the blood ... will pass over the door, and will not suffer the destroyer to come in unto your houses to smite you," Exodus 12: 21-23; (Fulfilled) "... For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us," 1 Corinthians 5:7.
- Sacrifice a sweet smelling savor unto the LORD: "Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, 'If ... you bring ... a burnt sacrifice ... a male without blemish ... to make atonement ... the priest shall burn ... the sacrifice ... by fire, of a sweet savor unto the LORD," Leviticus 1:2-9; (Fulfilled) "Walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given Himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet smelling savor," Ephesians 5:2.

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blood ... that makes an atonement for the soul," Leviticus 17:11; (Fulfilled) "... the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin," 1 John 1:7.

- The Father sent Him to speak His Word: "I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren ... and will put My Words in His mouth; and He shall speak unto them all that I shall command Him," Deuteronomy 18:18; (Fulfilled) "Jesus unto them, '... I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father hath taught Me, I speak these things," John 8:28.

A very great multitude ... went before, and that followed, cried, saying, 'Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is He that cometh in the Name of the LORD; Hosanna in the highest," Matthew 21:7-9.
